



Sixth Form Uniform Policy

As a Sixth Form student you are expected to lead by example and always be neat, tidy and appropriately dressed.

The Sixth Form has a different uniform from the rest of the school. Failure to be suitably dressed will lead to action by the Director of Sixth Form. You may be asked to return home to correct your uniform.

The uniform is as follows:

- Black V-neck, plain jumper or cardigan
- White shirt
- Black school tie
- Black tailored trousers
- Black knee length skirt/black pinafore dress (with white shirt and school tie worn underneath)
- Black/plain tights
- Black or brown shoes

Note:

- Jumpers will be plain black – no stripes or logo
- Trousers will be FORMAL (no denim or leggings)
- Boys will be clean shaven
- Face piercing will not be worn
- Outdoor clothing will not be worn in the school building
- Extremes of hair style are not permitted
- Earrings should be appropriate and at the discretion of Director of Sixth Form / Principal
