

## Year 7 Catch Up Funding Impact and Evaluation Report 2016 / 2017

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides schools with additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2).

## Objectives of Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up premium

To narrow the gap by providing intensive literacy and numeracy support and raise the attainment of those students entitled to Catch up Premium:

- To raise self-esteem and aspirations of students entitled to the premium;
- To enhance existing provision;
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress;
- To intervene quickly if any chosen strategy or intervention fails to show impact;
- To ensure that parents are informed and involved where appropriate.

Small Group Classes – Intensive low student to

Additional Specialist Literacy and Numeracy provision - through the SEN-Inclusion department additional staffing	
Pastoral Support – via the Academy's House pastoral system and dedicated support staff	
1 – 1 Reading and numeracy Intervention	
Parental Involvement – An invitation to parents through SEN teacher contact to explore how they can best support their children	
Increased Capacity in English and Mathematics — Additions have been made to the numeracy and literacy teams to provide increased teaching time per week of each core subject	
Literacy Resources – Comprehension, reading and writing materials. This funding has also been used to establish an additional Specialist Teacher of SEN role, focusing on mathematics and English catch up teaching.
