Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

Thank you to all students who have transitioned so well to the new guidance regarding face masks that have been in place since Monday 17 May. We retain a stock of spare face masks in school, but if your child will be travelling on school transport, please ensure they bring a facemask and suitable storage bag for when it is not in use. If individual students and staff wish to continue wearing face masks as per the guidance that was in place earlier this term, these individual decisions will continue to be supported within our school.

It should be noted that the reintroduction of face coverings for pupils, students or staff may be advised for a temporary period in response to particular localised outbreaks, including variants of concern. We will keep you informed of any further changes in guidance.
