Please note this number must only be used in the event of a positive result being confirmed.

A few general reminders to students in school are to please remember that payment at Meet N Eat is by fob only. If a student does not have a fob on a particular day, please speak to a member of the catering Team who will be able to ensure your child is able to purchase food. The Finance Office will inform you that your child's fob requires topping up. Also, as the weather improves please bring a bottle of water to school to ensure you are fully hydrated throughout the day.
