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Dear Students, Parents and Carers

Please find within this letter some key updates on our continuing response to the presence of Covid 19 within the community.

Lateral Flow Testing update

The latest update from the Gloucestershire Covid Support Team is as follows: *"UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) have been made aware of some areas reporting positive LFD test results with subsequent negative PCR tests and are currently looking into the cause. Whilst the UKHSA investigation is under-way, we advise that if a pupil or staff member has been in close contact with a positive case (such as a household member) or has displayed Covid-19 symptoms and has tested positive on an LFD (but subsequently tested negative on a PCR), they are treated as potentially infectious. We recommend they isolate and remain out of the setting, for 10 days."*

As such, if your child has been in close contact with a positive case (such as a household member) or has displayed Covid-19 symptoms and has tested positive on an LFD (but subsequently tested negative on a PCR), they are treated as potentially infectious. Please contact the school and we will recommend your child isolates and remains out of our school setting, for 10 days. We will continue to follow this latest guidance and will keep our school community informed of any further updates as we receive them.

A reminder please that home testing is one of the most effective ways to reduce the risk of transmission and support the continuation of face-to-face education and your support in this process is greatly appreciated. The government will continue to review the future need for testing in light of any changes to the public health situation and we will continue to follow Government guidance.
