Assessment Method	<p>Assessment objectives (AOs) are set by Ofqual and are the same across all A-level Art and Design specifications and all exam boards.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AO1: Develop ideas • AO2: Experiment with materials • AO3: Record observations • AO4: Present a personal and meaningful response <p>All work is marked by the class teacher; marks are then moderated by teachers across the department and submitted to the exam board by 31st May.</p> <p>An external moderator from the exam board then visits the school in June and moderates all marks.</p>
